- *A day of Joy and celebration
- *Celebration of new things
 - 1. Old Covenant v. New Covenant
 - 2. Mourning v. Joy
 - 3. Alone v Together
 - 4. Ignorance v. Understanding
 - 5. Aimlessness v. Purpose
 - 6. Selfishness v. Christ-filled

Goal: To celebrate what God accomplished on the cross and to encourage our hearts to burn with in us for the gospel

*This story should burst with the vitality of God's great power and the stark transformation of Jesus from death into life

*And that same power is inside of his followers

Romans 8:11

11 If the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, he who raised Christ Jesus[d] from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you.

Luke 24

- v.1-4 The first day of the week aka first day after the sabbath. Not only is it the first day of a new week, it is the first day of the New Covenant between God and his people.
- v.5 "Why do you seek the living among the dead?
 - 1. Stop looking for life in the dead things of this world.
- * There is nothing in this world that can give us life or bring us fulfillment. As a follower of Jesus, are you filled with life, or are you still looking around in dead stuff
 - 2. Stop going through the empty motions of life trapped by
 - *The same frustrations
 - *The same struggles
 - *The same feelings of inadequacy
 - *The same sins and temptations
 - 3. Jesus came to give life, an abundant life, with the power of the resurrection.

- v. 6-8 Reminder that everything happened on purpose, just as it was always planned and communicated several times
- v.9 Every account of encounters with Jesus inspire joy, celebration, and the intense desire to tell somebody
- v.25-27 Jesus begins to explain everything about why he had to die exactly the way he did. Every single action was foretold and necessary
- v.28-29 They were so enthralled with his explanation that they didn't want him to leave them
- v.30-31 Inside, Jesus reveals himself. Their eyes are opened.
- v.32 The truth of scripture left a burning, aching, longing desire inside their heart
 - 1. God's promises, God's word put a burning inside of them
 - 2. Holy Spirit is what gives us that burning desire
- v.33 That burning desire lead to ACTION
- 1. They were so excited and the fire burned so strongly that they just walked 7 miles back to Jerusalem
 - 2. Back to the place of

Hurt

Persecution

Despair

Rejection

v.33-34 They shared their testimony

- 1. Their encounter with Jesus wasn't so that they could
 - * Be comfortable and stay where they were
 - * Have personal story to ease their lot in life
 - * Not to give them warm fuzzy feeling
- 2. They got up and returned to the place of misery, to the place of brokenness and broken people to simply share all that God had showed them

- **The resurrection:
 - 1. Means Life
 - 2. Gives Joy
 - 3. Puts a fire deep in our heart
 - 4. Emboldens Us
 - 5. Changes Us
 - 6. Challenges Us
- **Their encounter w/ the risen Savior changed everything
 - 1. Emboldened them
 - 2. Empowered them
 - 3. Filled them with Joy
 - 4. Poured out blessing on them
 - 5. Moved them to worship
